#### Mission

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To provide financial assistance to low and moderate-income elderly, and/or disabled homeowners for the purpose of providing decent, safe, and sanitary housing conditions, as well as improving quality of life.

#### What Property is Eligible?

What Property is Eligible?

- Within the unincorporated area of Harris County, including Deer Park, Galena Park, Humble, Jacinto City, Katy, La Porte, Morgan's Point, Seabrook, Shoreacres, South Houston, Tomball and Webster
- Must pass an environment and historical evaluation and feasibility inspection performed by the Harris County Community Services Department

What Property NOT Eligible

- Property located within the boundaries of the cities of Houston, Pasadena and Baytown
- Property located within a 100-year flood plain without flood insurance



# Who is Eligible for Minor or Major Home Repair?

- Those who are the sole owners of a residential property
- Current on all property taxes
- Assets cannot exceed \$40,000
- Have not participated in a Harris County Home
  Repair program
  - For the past 5 years for minor repairs
  - For the past 10 years for major rehabilitation
- Owner must occupy property following completion of repairs

### Scope of Repair

Minor Repair (Grant Funded)

- For those 62 or older or who have someone with a documented disability in the home
- Up to \$20,000 for minor home repairs for those within 50% of the median category income (see chart)
- Includes roof repair/replacement, handicap accessibility improvements, mechanical, electrical, and weatherization and plumbing

Major Rehabilitation/Reconstruction

- For those in specific areas designated for revitalization. To find out more go to www.hrc.hctx.net/homerepair.htm or call (832) 927-4957
- Up to \$80,000 for rehabilitation for those within 80% of the median income category (see chart)
- Up to \$135,00 for reconstruction for those within 80% of the medial income category (see chart)
- Grant funded or interest only loan depending on income

#### Septic or Water Well (Grant Funded)

- Up to \$40,000 for replacement or repair
- No age limit
- Income cannot exceed the 80% level (see chart)

\*Income cannot exceed the level requirements.
